Madrid, 25-26 septiembre 2025

La inteligencia artificial (IA) se ha convertido en la tecnología disruptiva más presente, frecuente y transversal en el panorama jurídico actual. Su aplicación masiva, tanto en el ámbito público como en el privado, plantea desafíos sin precedentes para el Derecho, que se ve forzado a repensar sus conceptos, marcos normativos y metodologías.

Junto a la IA, otras tecnologías como el blockchain, la computación cuántica, la realidad aumentada y virtual, el Internet de las cosas (IoT) y la

automatización avanzada, están transformando la práctica jurídica y desafiando los límites tradicionales de la teoría del Derecho.

Este congreso propone un espacio de reflexión sobre el alcance y las implicaciones jurídicas de estos avances, con especial atención a la IA, aunando las perspectivas del mundo profesional y la investigación académica en España, Europa y con una mirada hacia EE.UU.

El programa incluirá mesas temáticas con expertos destacados y la presentación de comunicaciones seleccionadas por el Comité Científico (ver condiciones de envío). Los trabajos aceptados podrán ser publicados según las indicaciones editoriales que se facilitarán oportunamente.

Artificial Intelligence (AI) has rapidly become the most widespread, accessible, and cross-sectoral disruptive technology affecting the legal field today. Its pervasive use in both public and private sectors presents legal systems with unprecedented challenges, demanding a rethinking of legal concepts, regulatory structures, and interpretative approaches.

Alongside AI, other disruptive technologies—such as blockchain, quantum computing, virtual and

augmented reality, the Internet of Things (IoT), and advanced automation—are reshaping legal practices and raising foundational questions in legal theory.

This conference invites reflection on the scope and impact of these developments, with a particular focus on AI, bringing together voices from both professional practice and academic research across Spain, Europe, and the United States.

The program will include topic-based panels with leading experts, as well as the oral presentation of papers selected by the Scientific Committee (see submission guidelines). Selected contributions may be considered for publication according to forthcoming editorial instructions.
